Debarment of Phil Alain Didier Company Limited (PAD CO Ltd)

This is to inform you that following proposals for debarment made by both the Ministry of National Infrastructure and Community Development (National Development Unit) and the Ministry of Education, Tertiary Education, Science and Technology and pursuant to Regulations 3 and 14 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, Phil Alain Didier Company Limited (PAD CO Ltd) of Motorway M3, Riche Terre, Terre Rouge has been debarred from participating in public procurement for a period of **five years with effect from 15 September 2020 to 14 September 2025** for the following reasons:

- (a) Supplying false information in the process of submitting a bid or pre-qualification exercise;
- (b) Misconduct relating to the execution of procurement contracts; and
- (c) Any other misconduct relating to the responsibilities of the bidder.

2. Kindly ensure that Phil Alain Didier Company Limited (PAD CO Ltd) does not receive any procurement contract or participate in any procurement exercise during the period of debarment.

3. Pursuant to Regulation 4 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, any existing contract entered into between Phil Alain Didier Company Limited (PAD CO Ltd) and a public body shall not be affected by the debarment. Hence, Phil Alain Didier Company Limited (PAD CO Ltd) is required to deliver all on-going contracts in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.
