Return of Emergency Procurement for period December 2018 to Date

Further to Circular No. 3 of 2018, Directive No. 41 and Directive No. 44 issued by this Office, public bodies are required to submit a return of all procurement activities carried out under Emergency Procurement for period starting December 2018 to date.

3. The return must be forwarded in excel format by email to the PPO Secretariat at: pposecretariat@govmu.org within one week from the date of issue of this circular. A hard copy of the said return should be submitted to this office.
