**Amendment to electronic Standard Bidding Documents (e-SBD) for
Consultancy Services**

Our attention has been drawn to a discrepancy in the formula used for computing the final technical score under the QCBS in the e-SBD published documents for Consultancy Services.

2. Since the formula in the electronic procurement system is the correct one, the discrepancy in the final technical score will only arise if the computation is done manually.
3. The discrepancy has now been corrected in the new published e-SBD.
4. Public bodies are hereby requested to take action on ongoing Bidding exercises as appropriate.
