Debarment of Neo Clean Ltd

You are hereby informed that following proposal for suspension and debarment made by the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity and pursuant to Regulations 3 and 14 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, Neo Clean Ltd situated at 44, Deschartes Street, Port Louis, has been debarred from participating in public procurement for a period of **one year with effect from 23 June 2021 to 22 June 2022** for misconduct relating to the execution of a procurement contact.

2. Kindly ensure that *Neo Clean Ltd* does not receive any procurement contract or participate in any procurement exercise during the period of debarment.

3. Pursuant to Regulation 4 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, any existing contract entered into between *Neo Clean Ltd* and a public body shall not be affected by the debarment. Hence, *Neo Clean Ltd* is required to deliver all on-going contracts in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.
