Debarment of Kisten Enterprise Co. Ltd

You are hereby informed that following proposal for suspension and debarment made by the Ministry of Education, Tertiary Education, Science and Technology and pursuant to Regulations 3 and 14 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, **Kisten Enterprise Co. Ltd** situated at Chamouny Road, Chemin Grenier, has been debarred from participating in public procurement for a period of **three (3) years with effect from 10 August 2021 to 09 August 2024** for misconduct relating to the submission of a bid.

2 Kindly ensure that Kisten Enterprise Co. Ltd does not receive any procurement contract or participate in any procurement exercise during the period of debarment.

3. Pursuant to Regulation 4 of the Public Procurement (Suspension and Debarment) Regulations 2008, any existing contract entered into between Kisten Enterprise Co. Ltd and a public body shall not be affected by the debarment. Hence, Kisten Enterprise Co. Ltd is required to deliver all on-going contracts in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.
