Amendments to Standard Bidding Documents

The attention of Public bodies is hereby drawn to the following amendments brought to the General Conditions of Contract and Standard Bidding Documents for both paper based and electronic procurement.

A. Termination for Convenience.

The contract clause in respect to the above has been amended.

B. Final Account.

This clause has been amended to allow the Project Manager to make his own assessment with respect to the final payment certificate in case the contractor fails to submit his claim.

C. Termination clause

A new clause has been added to allow for termination of contract in case of a fundamental breach.

D. Changes to CIDB Legislation

The Standard Bidding Documents for both Works and Consultancy Services have been amended to simplify the existing clauses with regard to registration and compliance with the provisions in the CIDB legislation.

E. Margin of Preference

The Standard Bidding Documents for Goods have been amended in line with Directive 49 which deals with applicable Margin of Preference to Goods contracts.
