Institution of Performance Review Committee

- 1. In view to better monitor the performance of contractors, Directive 64 (Setting up of Performance Review Committee) was issued on 8 February 2022 highlighting the process for monitoring performance of contractors and dealing with non-performing contractors.
- 2. This Office has noted that many public bodies are not complying with Directive No. 64 which requires the setting up of a Performance Review Committee (PRC) by all public bodies. This non-compliance issue has also been raised at the meeting of the Fast Track Committee on Projects held on the 12 September 2022.
- 3. In view of the above, all public bodies falling under the PPA (2006) including institutions falling under their purview, are requested to set up a PRC and submit its composition to the Procurement Policy Office by 28 April 2023.
- 4. Non-compliance with the Directive will be dealt with in accordance with section7A (3) of the PPA (2006).
