Implementation of Online Platform for Return on Procurement Activities (ROPA)

1. Public bodies are hereby informed that, as part of ongoing measures to strengthen efficiency, transparency, and timeliness in procurement reporting, the Procurement Policy Office has introduced a new online platform for the submission of the ROPA. This digital system will enable public bodies to complete and submit ROPA on a real-time basis, upon completion of each procurement exercise. The online platform is accessible at the following link:

2. Accordingly, with effect from **27 April 2026**, the submission of the ROPA shall be carried out exclusively through the online ROPA platform. Manual submission of data **shall no longer be accepted**.

3. Access to the platform shall be effected using the designated public officer's **MAUPASS account and password**.

6. Public bodies are reminded that compliance with ROPA reporting requirements remains mandatory as per section 7(d) of the Public Procurement Act.
