## <u>Waiver of registration of Contractors and Consultants at Prequalification and</u> <u>Shortlisting stage</u>

- We have been informed that the Council of the Construction Industry and Development Board has waived the registration requirement for contractors and consultants at the stage of prequalification of contractors and shortlisting of consultants.
- 2. In view of the above, the Standard Prequalification Document (SPD) for large or complex works now allows for already registered contractors not to submit evidences of their general experience and average annual construction turnover while non-registered Contractors have to submit these documentary evidences.
- 3. Public bodies are also advised to apply the waiver when shortlisting consultants.
- 4. However, the registration requirement with the CIDB remains mandatory at the time of submission of bids and proposals.
- 5. You are kindly requested to disseminate the content of this Circular to all those concerned within your organisation.
